To be completed by faculty sponsor/advisor

Students earn credit by completing their internship activity, by meeting at least 2 times with their faculty sponsor during the semester, and by completing all components of the Internship Packet.

Grade Breakdown (200 points total)

- A 10-12 page academic research paper with an annotated bibliography (see rubric)– 90 points
- An evaluation from your site supervisor – 40 points
- A reflection journal (guidelines in Checklist for Success) - 30 points
- A record of hours worked, i.e., your “time sheets,” with days/hours clearly marked and totaled. *Students need at least 120 work hours to earn 3 academic credits (75% of the time must be completed on-site); please notify your advisor if your work site changes.* – 20 points
- At least 2 meetings with faculty sponsor/advisor – 10 points
- A newly-updated resume that now includes internship experience – 10 points
